

INSTRUMENT RATING MULTI-ENGINE



Introduction

The Instrument Rating is a qualification that allows a pilot to fly an aircraft by day or night under the Instrument Flight Rules (IFR).

Most professional pilots will need an Instrument Rating to work in all weather charter and aerial work operations and to gain entry into an airline.

During the Instrument Rating Multi-Engine course, you will develop your instrument flying skills to a highly accurate standard. You will learn how to safely operate a multi-engine aircraft in variable weather conditions and to conduct Instrument Departures, Arrivals and Approaches including:

Instrument Approach 3D
Instrument Approach 2D

- PPL or CPL
- Class 2 or Class 1 Medical
- Multi-Engine Class Rating
- NIGHT VFR RATING*

(*Applicants not holding a NVFR Rating, will require an additional night VFR component)
